The movement quickly gained followers in the German states, the Burgundian Netherlands, regions of France and Scandinavia.

As any hope of reforming the Catholic Church faded, the Protestants separated from Rome, resulting in Lutheran Churches in Germany and Scandinavia and Reformed Churches in Switzerland and the Netherlands.
